

Biona BPA Policy

Bisphenol-A (BPA) is a plastic resin compound commonly used in food and drinks packaging, acting as a barrier layer between food and the metal container, namely in canned pulses, soups, or as a barrier inside metal lids on jars and bottles.

At Biona, we only use certified BPA-Free and BPA-NI cans and lids for our organic food products.

BPA-NI (non-intentional) means that BPA has not been added as a barrier compound when manufacturing the cans or lids. However, BPA may be present in the environment, and very small amounts may be picked up as the foods are processed.
